



## Growing Skilled Spellers

## How We Teach It

### Real-Life Application

Throughout the course, students receive real-life writing applications to teach them how to use the words they learn to spell.

Spelling 2 has 32 weekly word lists of 20 words each, grouped into word families based on spelling generalizations to help students recognize patterns and learn to spell.
