

#### **Updates**


This edition is a complete rewrite of both the teacher and student editions, with an updated scope and sequence, new chapters, and deleted chapters. It introduces a new teaching approach in both the student and teacher editions. Objectives have changed considerably, and student edition content is now tied to specific objectives at the paragraph level. This edition adds four recurring activities—case studies, primary source analyses, webquests, and apologetics activities—to provide practical points of application for Bible truths.
