#### **Updates**

The 3rd edition of *Fundamentals of Literature* adds the reading process approach to each lesson, which helps with comprehension and critical thinking through questioning before, during, and after reading. This close reading focus is a major instructional change. The teacher edition has scaffolded lessons that help students understand complex texts. Each unit now has a biblical worldview shaping theme, and new selections have been included to meet objectives.

Because of these changes, this edition is not compatible with its predecessor.
